Gbm purchases energy from renewable sources, has implemented a closed-loop refrigeration system that eliminates water consumption and invests in machinery and production equipment with the lowest possible energy consumption.

2. Using energy from renewable sources.

Gbm has installed a photovoltaic system that covers 40% of its annual energy consumption and uses transport vehicles powered by green diesel.

3. Recycling waste.

With a complete waste sorting system, Gbm currently recycles 95% of the waste generated.

4. Health, safety and people's well-being.

5. The health of individuals, workplace safety, and the quality of work environments are essential for sustainable development. We actively promote a safe and healthy work environment and encourage responsible and sustainable behaviour among all employees.

6. Social sustainability.

GBM engages with the local community by making a positive contribution and ensuring a development approach that does not negatively impact the surrounding environment, while also supporting the community with particular attention to future generations.
